

## Hygiene measures implemented in 2021 and 2022

### Before arrival

Availability on the website of [ADN](#) Tourism's recommendations concerning good cleaning and disinfection practices for tourist accommodation dated May 2020.

Guests are asked to bring masks, hand sanitizer and slippers or indoor shoes.

### Home

- Wearing a mask in all common areas.
- Provision of hydroalcoholic gel at the entrance.
- Instructions given to disinfect your hands when entering.

### Rooms

- Plasticized regulations in the rooms.
- Provision of hydroalcoholic gel at the entrance of each room.
- Plastic protection on the flat surfaces of wooden furniture to be able to disinfect them with an alcoholic solution.
- Materials renewed to each customer: tourist documentation, notebook and pens.
- Disinfection of key sets given to hosts.

### Breakfasts

- The space available is sufficient to ensure regulatory distancing,
- Breakfasts are served in the dining room and / or outdoors.
- All fabric materials have been removed: bread basket, table runner, napkins and replaced with plastic sets, compostable single-use napkins and washable containers.
- All foods 'containers (like for bread, butter, jams, cheeses) are dedicated by rooms.
- Collective containers are handled only by the owners (coffee, milk, fruit juice).
- Wearing masks for the preparation of breakfasts.
- Fruits and vegetables are washed with soapy water just after purchase, rinsed and dried.
- For all fresh products, the overpack is removed and the packaging is disinfected before putting in the refrigerator.
- Other products are left in the open air for several hours before being stored.

### Tables d'hôtes

- In accordance with the instructions of the OT, we no longer insure the tables d'hôtes in the usual configuration.

- We encourage guests to frequent the restaurants (list of restaurants available)
- If necessary, we offer on-site consumption of takeaway meals or meal trays served in the same hygienic conditions as breakfasts.

### **Cleaning and disinfection**

- Systematic ventilation of the rooms.
- Wearing a coveralls, mask and gloves for handling dirty laundry.
- All bedding is changed after each customer including waterproof mattress pads and waterproof pillow protectors.
- Washing laundry at 60°C with Sanytol (EN14476) in rinse water or at 40°C with Sanytol in wash water and rinse water.
- The sanitary facilities are cleaned with a bleach-based solution.
- Once the cleaning is complete, disinfection with an EN14476 approved solution of all surfaces and objects handled by customers: nightstand, desks, chairs, door and window handles, switches, shelves, hangers, garbage cans, plasticized documentation.
- Entrance door handles and stair railing are disinfected several times a day
- The common areas as well as the kitchen are cleaned daily according to the same protocol as the rooms.
- Increase to 70°C in the washing temperature of the dishwasher.
